4. Presentations

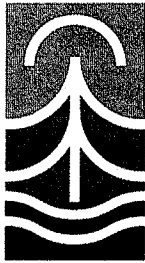
- DTI – 7:15 pm
 - i. Council welcomed Jesse McCaw Regional Director from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure to the chambers. Discussions of road maintenance throughout the municipality and the structure of DTI branches since there have been changes since DTI previous year visit. Councillors raised concerns to specific areas within the municipality and the quality of the roads, ditches, culverts and chip sealing. McCaw suggested a quarterly meeting with the CAO to voice any concerns and to discuss the long-term future for road maintenance plans.

- SWEB Mountain Ash Wind Energy Project Community Engagement Session at Harvey High School, June 4th, 2025, 4:40-7:30 PM (drop-in)
- HMCC MOU update Capital Allocation Strategy
 - ii. CAO discussed with Council that the HMCC board are waiting to have a meeting regarding the potential transfer of ownership in June with nothing more to report.
- Annual Report
 - iii. CAO discussed with Council have begun and are in the final stages.
- External Audit
 - iv. CAO discussed with Council have begun and are in the final stages and KPMG will be at the Council meeting in June.



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- Capital Region Resiliency Network Grant
 - v. CAO discussed with Council that this fund will go towards supporting the start-up of a Gathering Space program in Harvey. This program, designed for those aged 55+ aims to promote social inclusion by offering an area where attendees can gather, play a game, share a coffee, or just chat. Half of the funds will go towards a Grand Opening, with the remaining covering start-up costs.
- Gros Morne Institute for Sustainable Tourism (GMIST) Award
 - ii. CAO discussed with Council that staff have been looking for opportunity for economic development for local business and tourism. Administration has submitted an application and subsequently won the award for HRC to participate.

- Updated 2025 Emergency Response Plan

- Amending Village of Harvey Rural Plan (By-law 2020-02)
 - b) CAO discussed with Council there has been a request from owner of Excel Manufacturing to expand his current business within the Village of Harvey. Currently, the PID that Excel is requesting to expand for his business is zoned residential and the PID would need to be rezoned as industrial. There would need to be an amendment to the Village of Harvey Rural Plan. CAO stated the next step to proceed with an amendment to the Village of Harvey Rural Plan will be for Council to make a motion for a Public Hearing at our Special Meeting of Council.

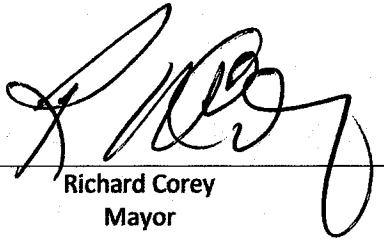
